A 15-year-old boy from Delhi wins the Diana Award

New Delhi [India], June 28 (ANI): A 15-year-old boy from Delhi received the prestigious Diana Award for his work beyond everyday life to create and sustain positive change.

A student at Wellington College (UK), Ishan Kapur received the Diana Award, the highest praise young people can achieve for their social behavior and humanitarian efforts.

Ishan is working with Sri Rama Krishna Ashram New Delhi. He helps local schools access the uniforms of the girls left behind.

Ishan has funded the Pound 5000 and devised and implemented an ambitious campaign to collect nearly 100 laptops and tablets for teachers and students. We also made learning accessible to everyone online during a long national blockade.

The Diana Award was established to commemorate the Welsh princess Diana. The award is awarded by a charity of the same name and is supported by both her sons, the Duke of Cambridge and the Duke of Sussex.

His compassion and dedication allowed young people to continue their education despite many obstacles. Ishan is an outstanding example of his community.

The award winners were given by adults who know young people professionally and are recognized as a positive contribution to society. Through a rigorous nomination process, these nominees needed to demonstrate their influence in five key areas: vision, social impact, inspiring others, youth leadership, and a journey of service.

There are 12 Diana Awards judging panels representing the UK and 3 panels representing countries outside the UK. Each panel has three judges. One youth, an education or youth organization representative, a government representative. The main purpose is deciding which nominations from each region / country / country in the UK will win the Diana Award.
